

Delegations are requested to bring their national flag and in digital format their national anthem. These must be handed to the LOC Secretariat (Competition Office) by the Head of Delegation upon arrival at the time of accreditation.

VISA

Federations requiring an official invitation to obtain a visa are asked to contact the LOC timely, by sending the official visa form to info@dutchtrampolineopen.com

LOC SAFEGUARDING OFFICER

From the events' official date of arrival until the official day of departure, participants (gymnasts, coaches, judges and any other delegation members) have the opportunity to contact by phone or email a Safeguarding Officer in case of harassment, abuse of any type, if they are worried or do not feel comfortable.

INSURANCE

The World Gymnastics Technical Regulations foresee that all participating Federations are responsible for making their own arrangements to have the necessary valid insurance coverage against illness, accidents and repatriation for all the members of their Delegation. Basic insurance (sickness, accident, and repatriation) in your country of residence is compulsory in order to be able to benefit from coverage by FIG IMSSA subsidiary insurance. Please also refer to <https://www.gymnastics.sport/site/pages/medical-insurance.php> for additional information regarding the World Gymnastics IMSSA insurance for Athletes and Judges.

If the note has not been sent in advance to the LOC (which is strongly recommended), the LOC will verify the insurance coverage upon arrival of the delegation members (e.g. cover note or photocopy of the valid policy).

The insurance must be valid at least starting from the arrival day of the delegation and must last for the delegations' entire stay.

OFFICIAL LANGUAGE

The official language of this World Cup is English. Announcements will be made in English only. Interpretation from and into any other language must be organized by the delegations.



ACCREDITATION AND ID CARDS

All delegation members will receive an accreditation ID Card. The accreditation ID Card is personal, non-transferable, and compulsory to get access to the training and competition hall, functions, and the bus system. All participants and officials are required to wear the ID Cards **at all times**. Access to the venue, transportation or meal sites will be refused if a valid accreditation card is not presented.

Accreditation will take place at the LOC Competition Office (accreditation desk) in the competition venue. All delegations will be directed to the accreditation procedure from the airport. Delegations travelling by car must go first to the LOC Competition Office.

At accreditation Heads of Delegation are required to

- provide a valid **phone number** (working in The Netherlands) and **e-mail address**. These contact details will be used as mailboxes to inform all competition results, information and occurrences during and after the competition.
- verify the names of their entire delegation and present to the LOC the valid passport of all Delegation Members for proof of identity and Nationality
- confirm the NF contact details onsite (email and mobile phone) for proper delivery of the gymnasts' start list, judges' list and results
- provide proof of the fulfilment of all financial obligations to the LOC and finalize the necessary payments if needed (i.e. insurance, additional accreditation, etc.)
- verify the accommodation and meal requirements
- verify the return flight schedules
- provide their confirmation of insurance
- 2 copies of competition cards for each gymnast/synchro pair
- hand in their national flag and the National Anthem in a digital format
- provide bank details to be used to pay the money for the awarded gymnasts (but only when the bank account that the Federation has paid the entry fee from cannot be used to transfer the prize money)

In order to accelerate the process of accreditation, each participating Federation is kindly requested to send photos of each member of its delegation until 1st February, 2026.

It is mandatory to send photos of delegation members such as medical staff and HOD that do not have a World Gymnastics' license to the LOC latest February 28.

The photos (identity colour photo in jpg format) should clearly indicate the corresponding full name in the file title.

In addition, the LOC will distribute information regarding the safeguarding Officer operations plan upon accreditation

The Organizing Committee will provide bus transportation between Schiphol airport, hotels, and the competition venue for arrival/departure, training and competition.

Buses from/to the hotels and the competition venue will be on a regular basis. A detailed schedule will be provided to delegations upon arrival and will be available at the hotels and at the competition office. Vans are available for extra transport requests.

The bus schedule is tailored to busier times, however when a bus is full with the maximum number of passengers, contact the Transport coordinator at 0031 620533185 for extra capacity by Van(s) or an extra (emergency) bus.

The transport is for the use of the delegations who have booked their accommodation through the LOC. Bus tickets can also be booked separately at the competition office.

ORIENTATION MEETING

The Orientation Meeting will take place **Wednesday March 11th at 11:30-12:00** in the Touch Down at the competition venue | 1st floor.

All Heads of Delegation must attend the meeting. One extra Official per delegation may also attend. Judges cannot be representatives of their NF at the Orientation Meeting.

At this meeting all information concerning the detailed organization of the World Cup will be given by the Organizing Committee and World Gymnastics. All information will be in English only.

A beforementioned QR code will be available for delegations to attend the Delegation Group App. The App will be used for announcements from, and requests for information to the LOC during this World Cup. The tel.nr./WhatsApp of the LOC on site during competition is **+31 638270180**

VENUE ACCESS

The access to the Arena will be limited to the training/competition group. Besides gymnasts, access will be allowed only to accredited persons.

EQUIPMENT

Equipment during warmup and competition:

CHALK

Chalk will be provided for Warm up Hall and Competition Hall.

Also individual liquid chalk bottles will be available at the competition office.

WARM UP

Immediately prior to the Qualifying Rounds and Finals each gymnast/pair will be allowed 45 seconds of warm-up on the competition apparatus, per World Gymnastics regulations.

MARCH IN

The gymnasts are asked to assemble in the staging area next to the competition office latest 5 minutes prior to each competition group. The gymnasts must wear competition attire (as per Code of Points)

All gymnasts must leave the competition hall at the same time through the exit leading to the Mixed Zone.



STARTING ORDER – DRAWING OF LOTS

The drawing of lots and starting order will take place on February 25, 2026 in the World Gymnastics office and published on the World Gymnastics website.

The list of finalists will be provided to the Heads of Delegation after the qualifications. Any withdrawal from the Finals must be declared in writing with the LOC.

The World Cup Competition draw, the competition groups, the starting lists, the training groups, the training schedule, and the competition schedule are based on the assumption that all registered federations will participate in accordance with their nominative registrations. Should there be any changes to participating numbers at the time of the competition, the World Gymnastics T&T TC in consultation with the LOC reserve the right to make adjustments which will facilitate the smooth running of the competition.

JUDGES MEETING – DRAWING OF LOTS

The judges' meeting is compulsory for all judges. All information will be in English only. Judges who do not participate in the judges' instruction may not be authorized to judge and their respective federations may face a penalty fee.

Trampoline judges meeting and score instruction: Wednesday March 11th at 16:00 in the Touch Down at the competition venue | 1st floor

The judges will be drawn after the judges' instruction.



SUPERIOR JURY

The World Gymnastics Delegate will act as President of the **Superior Jury**.

COMPETITION

The Competition Director and the Floor Manager will be in charge of the Competition and Warm up areas. All instructions given by them must be strictly observed, especially during TV broadcast (i.e. in relation with the marching in and out, Kiss & Cry, etc.)

KISS & CRY

The number of persons authorized in the Kiss & Cry is:

- 1 gymnast and 1 official for Individual Competition
- 2 gymnasts and 1 official for Synchronized Competition

This rule has to be strictly respected.
